ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. On June 25, 2026, the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) filed with the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) an application seeking approval to increase its individual information technology (IT) capital project reporting threshold from \$2 million to \$5 million (Application);
- B. The ICBC IT capital reporting requirements for individual IT capital reports are established via Order G-86-06, Letter L-82-06, Order G-3-08, Order G-189-11, and Order G-139-18;
- C. By Order G-139-18 dated July 26, 2018, the BCUC directed ICBC to file an individual IT capital project report with the BCUC for comments once internal corporate approvals have been achieved, but before implementation, whenever an individual IT project is estimated to exceed a capital expenditure of \$2 million; and
- D. The BCUC has reviewed the Application and considers that the following determinations are warranted.

NOW THEREFORE the BCUC orders as follows:

- 1. A regulatory timetable for the review of the Application is established as set out in Appendix A to this order.
- 2. As soon as is practicable, but no later than Wednesday, July 22, 2026, ICBC is directed to:
 - a. Provide a copy of the Application and this order on its website at <https://www.icbc.com> and its existing social media platforms; and

- b. Provide a copy of the Application and this order, electronically where possible, to registered interveners in the 2018 ICBC Application to Streamline Information Technology Compliance Reporting Requirements proceeding.
3. ICBC is directed to provide to the BCUC, by July 24, 2026, confirmation of compliance with the public notice requirements set out in Directive 2, including a list of parties notified and a list of social media platforms on which the notice was posted.
