This form is to be used only to add a related individual to an approved and actively licensed collector motor vehicle. For this purpose, ICBC adopts the "related individual" definition as used in the Property Transfer Tax Act: (a) a person's spouse (legally married or living for a continuous period of at least 2 years with another person in a marriage-like relationship), child, grandchild, great-grandchild, parent, grandparent, great-grandparent, or sibling, or (b) the spouse of a person's child, grandchild or great grandchild, or (c) the child, parent, grandparent or great-grandparent of a person's spouse.

NOTE: Only the individual who was initially approved for the Collector program may add a related individual to the registered ownership of a collector motor vehicle.

If there have been any other changes or modifications to your vehicle since it was approved, then you must re-apply to the Collector program. If more than one related individual is to be added, each individual will need to complete this form. Keep the applications together so they can be processed at the same time.

In most cases there will be a **new plate fee** along with other fees (e.g. transfer of ownership/cancel policy) to add a related individual.
