



Renewal of Occupational Therapy Service Level Agreement (SLA) for existing service providers

ICBC is pleased to let you know the [Performance Standards](#) for Occupational Therapists (OTs) has been updated and will take effect February 15, 2022. Approved OTs and Firms who would like to remain on the ICBC Approved OT List must renew their application by January 15, 2022. An email has been distributed to Approved OTs and Firms currently on the ICBC Approved OT List.

Firms or OTs that do not submit completed documentation to ICBC by January 15, 2022, or that otherwise do not meet and maintain eligibility requirements to ICBC's satisfaction, may not be approved and/or may be removed from the OT program.

Occupational therapists and/or firms who are not currently on the ICBC Approved OT List but who wish to apply are encouraged to do so. Interested firms must apply for an ICBC vendor number and submit all necessary documents outlined for both general and practitioner specific requirements.
