## Re: Supporting a Healthy Workplace

In July we announced an initiative to support our collision repair partners' efforts in fostering a supportive and collaborative work environment by offering complimentary training. We're now moving forward with the next phase of this initiative to build upon the learning and growth that you've already achieved.

## Healthy workplace culture training for all employees

As mentioned above, the first step of this initiative was providing training for those who work in leadership roles at Collision Repair Program facilities. We've received positive feedback from those who have completed the training.

For the next phase of this initiative, we'd like to continue providing support to our collision repair partners by offering the training to all employees who work for a Collision Repair Program facility. Everyone's time is valuable; we aim to ensure everyone has a convenient way to complete the training. We'll be offering two options for Collision Repair Program facility employees: a scheduled virtual Zoom meeting with a facilitator or an online self-directed course that can be completed at the employee's convenience.

I want to assure you the training is completely voluntary and free of charge. As was the case with the first round of training, we'll be providing \$40.00 to the repair facility for each employee who completes the training. For more information please visit our Partner's Page.

Later this month, the virtual Zoom meetings with a facilitator will be available to all Collision Repair Program facility employees. The meetings are approximately 60 minutes and are offered online with a facilitator from Hone Consulting. In an effort to accommodate employee's schedules, morning, afternoon and evening sessions will be available.

After registering, you will receive a confirmation email. We will need to know the names of all the employees you are registering, as well as their preferred training date.

The online self-directed course will be available for repair facility employees starting October 2nd, and the training can be completed at their convenience. We will then provide you with the website link and an access code. When completing the course, the employee will be required to enter their name, their organization's name, and their access code.
